

Presidential Preference Election voting sites listed

KINGMAN – Several voting precincts have been consolidated for Arizona’s February 28 Presidential Preference Election (PPE).

“The PPE is a special election that, this year, only the Republican Party and the Green Party have chosen to be on ballots,” Mohave County Elections Director Allen Tempert said. “This is not a primary election and does not follow the Arizona Open Primary laws. Anyone who is not registered as a member of one of those two parties will not be able to vote on February 28.”

As a special election that is focused on a limited number of people, “some of the polls have been consolidated,” he said. “We went from 73 voting precincts down to 32 plus eight All-Mail Election precincts. Those residents who are registered with the Green or Republican parties and live in All-Mail Election precincts will receive their ballots in the mail. Sample ballots are mailed out to all households with a registered Green or Republican Party resident. Those sample ballots will contain voters’ poll site addresses.”

Voting sites are also listed on the Mohave County website (www.co.mohave.az.us) by selecting “Department,” “Elections,” and then “Presidential Preference Election.”

The All-Mail Election precincts are 4 Chloride, 8 Meadview, 9 Dolan Springs, 21 Littlefield, 26 Oatman, 31 Yucca, 32 Truxton and 45 White Hills.
